POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

ARTICLE I

MEMBERSHIP

(See Bylaws Sections 2.0 and 2.1.1)

Membership Eligibility and Application

POLICY: The membership of the Association shall be open to all interested alumni, former students, faculty, staff, and friends who are in good standing with the Association and who meet the criteria for at least one of the membership categories defined by the Bylaws.

DEFINITIONS: For the purpose of the Bylaws, an applicant shall be considered "in good standing" when the applicant --

1. Donates to the Mississippi University for Women Foundation at least forty dollars (\$40.00) annually (except for those membership categories specifically exempted from donation requirements by the Bylaws);
2. Agrees to abide by the Bylaws and Policies/Procedures of the Association; and
3. Agrees to adhere to affiliation agreements approved by the Board of Directors of the MUW Alumni Association.

PROCEDURES:

1. Application for membership will be made to the MUW Office of Alumni Relations in writing by personal letter (including email or fax) or upon delivery of a completed application form provided by the Office of Alumni Relations.
2. Renewal of membership shall be automatic so long as the member remains in good standing as defined by this policy.

3. Verification of eligibility for membership shall be made by the Office of Alumni Relations. When there is a question of eligibility, the issue will be determined by a majority vote of the Board of Directors taken in Executive Session with only the voting Directors present.
