**POLICIES AND PROCEDURES**

**ARTICLE III**

**GOVERNANCE**

(See Bylaws Section 3.6)

**Appeals to Board of Directors**

**POLICY:** A decision by the Board of Directors may be appealed by the membership by written request stating the reasons that the decision should be reversed.

**PROCEDURES:**

1. Upon receiving a written letter requesting repeal of a decision by the Board of Directors, the President of the Board will place the request on the agenda of a regular meeting or may call a special meeting to deal with the request.
2. The member submitting the request will be notified of the date, time, and place of the meeting and, upon request, will be provided scheduled time on the agenda to discuss the member's concerns with the Board.
3. The Board will review the request in Executive Session at which time a two-thirds vote will be required to over-ride the original decision. Only the voting Directors of the Board shall be present during discussion of the appeal and the subsequent vote.
4. The decision of the Board shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting and reported to the requesting member in person or by letter from the Board of Directors.
